

NATALIA SAURIN

Natalia is a photographer and video artist. Born in Buenos Aires, she graduated in Architecture from the Politecnico di Milano and now lives and works in Milan. Her quest is to discover how myth and everyday life are interconnected, through symbols, legends and daily experiences. She has always been interested in classical and religious iconography, in recent years dedicating her research to the relationship between the body and the sacred.

In 2018 the book "Natalia Saurin, between myth and everyday life" has been published by Moondi editori, the first monograph of the editorial series Art. Since 2000 her work has been displayed in numerous exhibitions in Italy and abroad. In 2010, she won first prize at the Renaissance Arts Prize (London) in the category of Video Art. She has also participated in several Artist in residence projects, among which she was invited to the American Camargo Foundation in Cassis (France) in 2011 to work on the "Les trois M" project, in which she traced the steps of the three Marias. In 2014 she was invited to Catania for the project "My little house" during which she realized a project entitled "The Two Mothers" where personal and city history intertwined.

She is represented by Visualcontainer, a video art distributor based at [.BOX] Videoart Project space in Milan; the videos has been screened at festivals such as VideA, Visionaria, Fiaticorti, Giffoni and Optica (Spain, Argentina, Bolivia, France). Her artistic activity is accompanied by work related to communication and advertising.
