New Church Electoral Roll

This year we are required to complete an entirely **NEW** church electoral roll. This means that **everyone** who wishes their name to be included on the roll must apply on a special form. *Even if your name is on the present roll, you will need to re-apply, please.* Forms have been distributed by hand or post and should be returned to Imogen as soon as possible and **before 15 March**. Anyone who is not yet on the roll and would like their name to be added, please ask for a form. Entry on the roll entitles you to attend the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) at which we elect our Churchwardens and members of the PCC, approve the accounts and receive reports of the activities of our churches during the past year. After 6 months, you will become eligible to stand for election to the PCC. Please do consider supporting our churches in this way.
