Christmas Cheer in Yangon & Pekhon: 1-10 Dec-2017

A team of 9 volunteers: Joseph Tham, Sandra Wong, Patrick Yap, Irene See, Jack Low, Joanna Yu, Anne Siew, Cecilia Villenguez & Ana Bao participated in this year's mission. Sr. Jacqueline, Sr. Heza, Sr. Antonia, Postulants Magdalena

& Anita accompanied them. Altogether they visited St. Joseph's Church & 84 mile village in Yangon & 8 other remote villages in Pekhon (Shan State). They journeyed courageously in 4-wheel drive vehicles along bumpy dirt tracks and steep mountain slopes as well as by boat across Inle Lake to bring Christmas Cheer to 1,192 poor children, providing each with a good meal, blanket and goodie bag. In addition, they distributed a sack of rice, cooking oil, biscuits & blankets to each of the 165 poor families in 6 of the villages.









"Everywhere we witnessed villagers living in simple and basic conditions – firewood for cooking, no running water, drinking and bathing from the wells, poor hygiene, etc. Some poor families have only 1 meal a day. There were many heartfelt scenes of mothers sharing a meal with their children, of older children sharing and feeding their younger siblings. Women walked for miles to work on farms or collect firewood from the forests in lonely and remote tracks. Young mothers with infants at their breasts or on their backs walking on muddy tracks to tend to their daily chores. The men folk were not often sighted as they would be away from the village tending to the rice fields, farms, etc and slept there."

Children's Camp at Danbi: 26 Dec· 2017 - 1 Jan· 2018

The theme of the camp was "Peace and Reconciliation". There were 450 children, 100 facilitators, 50 cooks, 4 St. Francis Xavier Sisters, local community supporters besides the 9 member team: Sr. Jacqueline, Sr. Antonia, Sr. Heza, Postulants Magdalena & Anita, volunteers from Singapore: Ana Bao, Quek Lee Ngoh & Jane Wang. Each day began with morning Mass celebrated by Fr Sune Sune. Sessions on "PEACE" were interspersed with games and meaningful group activities. The children participated enthusiastically in all the activities, particularly in the telematch. Bishop John Mahn Hsane Hgyi of Pathein came to visit. The camp concluded with a reconciliation service and candlelight procession to welcome the New Year. Project Kyrie Singapore sponsored the food, blankets & goody bags.
