Formation of Educators Programme

The 13th Batch of 20 young ladies from villages in different parts of Myanmar, started the 6 months residential training course for the Formation of Educators on 5 July 2021 at Canossa Home.



The Training Programme includes these areas:

- Self-development: Myself and others, hopes and dreams, call and passion etc
- Education: purpose, models, child psychology, discipline, presentation skills,
- Mathematics, English, Myanmar, Faith Education, Health and Care of the sick, Music, art and craft, sewing and baking
- Faith formation & spirituality of educators.

The Team of Trainers includes Sisters: Sr Angela, Sr Joana, Sr. Maria, Sr. Antonia, Sr. Heza; Novices: Magdalena and Anita, Postulant Susana and Educators Hazel, Esther, Maricelin, Christina, Joana and Sophia.

Volunteers from Singapore will be offering some enrichment sessions online via ZOOM since they are not able to travel to Myanmar.

They will complete their course on 18 December. After their Graduation, they will be sent off to teach children in their villages together with appropriate resources.

Each trained educator will be given a stipend of \$100 for 3 months and will be monitored by their trainers.
