
Graces received ...


I FEEL AS IF I HAD BEEN MIRACULOUSLY HEALED...

So M. Caterina Geranio asserts. She attributes the Grace to M. Fernanda Riva. "For some time, she says, I had felt pain in the cardiac zone, exhaustion, difficulty in breathing, lack of appetite: a pleural extravasation was taking place. On friday 6th September 2013 at the Policlinic in Milan they hospitalized me in the coronary unit. I was then transferred to the cardiology ward and later sent to the Pio Trivulzio rehabilitation centre. There my breathing problems started again. In the night between Sept. 30th and Oct.1st a cardiac decompensation and a pulmonary edema brought me to the brink of death. I was urgently taken to S.Luke (a hospital specialized in cardiology); my case was considered very serious. After a lot of treatments, on Nov. 13th, I was transferred to our Infirmary in Tradate. There I started recovering. When finally I went back to my new community in Milan I could live a normal life and I came to know that my excommunity, in Rome-Ottavia, had prayed Ven. Fernanda Riva for my healing. I heartly thank M. Fernanda for having granted me this grace".
