Are we missing any opportunities? If so, what are they?	 Gather information on business skills, 'How to Start a New Business' workshop, seminars, etc. Look into translating Building Codes Keep neighborhoods 'healthy' (ie housing, safety, adequate street lighting, etc.) Communication barriers; close the language gap The conversation then took a turn when someone indicated that we truly don't have any 'problems' to solve. We just need to become a more inclusive community. Inclusive meaning that we need to build a more respect and support system amongst each other. This is somewhat currently happening at the City Library, Super Saver and Wells Fargo bank. Amanda Levos with GIPS has some ideas and Nicki will schedule a time to 'chat' with her (ie levels of inter-cultural competency). It was also mentioned that we should explore more opportunities to simply 'spend time together. (ie Multi-cultural Farmers Market). It was also suggested that we go through a Current Assets and Obstacles exercise (education, activities/events, housing, workforce, etc.).
