- Collect milk from farms and unload at relevant sites as instructed.
- Collect milk samples for in house and external testing.
- Undertake strict pre-unload sample tests of milk which includes Critical Control Point 1 antibiotic test.
- Adhere to collection of bulk milk samples for laboratory examination as stated in DAR 002.
- Undertake the tipping and transhipping of tanker.
- Undertake the CIP cleaning of tanker.
- Other associated jobs.
