Horse Show Mom (or Dad) 101

Welcome to the world of horse showing! You have just taken on a very fun and important role. When we first started showing, many years ago, we learned that a list is the most important packing tool! We have put the following sheet together for show riders, and their parents, to ensure you don't leave any important items at home on the day of the show.

Caboodle (Make-up case preferably with a mirror):

- Pick a color your rider will like. They usually like to customize them to make them "their own".
- Covered rubber bands to allow hair to stay in a tight pony tail under the bun.
- Hair color coordinated hair nets keep a few of these with you in case of holes
- · Bobbie pins that also coordinate with hair color
- Large barrette (about 3 to 4 inches long) this is what the
 hair bun is formed around. Be certain to select a clip that will
 hold all your hair securely. You may also use brown or black
 shoestrings.
- Small hair bow for the bottom of her hair bun to coordinate with her outfit (you will probably end up with a million of these by the time her show career is over)
- Make up for the Caboodle eye shadow, mascara, blush and lipstick. (Foundation can be staining to shirt collars)
- Small hair brush
- Hairspray
- Travel size baby powder for sweaty hands to help in slipping on your show gloves
- Pack of tissues
- · Safety pins of all sizes just in case
- Show jewelry: earrings, lapel pins, tie bars, etc.
- Number magnets rather than pins to securely hold your number. Holes in show apparel reduce the value for re-sale.
- Black tape (or brown with chocolate outfits)
- We recommend keeping the caboodle packed all the time for use only at shows, not daily use. Otherwise, all the items will miraculously disappear before the show and you'll be scampering around borrowing items from friends at the last minute.

Academy riders need the following clothing and accessories:

- Jods (Kentucky Jodhpurs)
- Shirt long sleeve button up dress shirt with collar holes
- Vest and tie
- Socks
- Helmet either black with black or navy jods, chocolate with chocolate jods, or for the younger riders we can custom match the paint to match their outfit.
- Paddock boots patent leather or matte. Brown or black to

- match jods, gloves and helmet
- Gloves same color as boots
- Tie bar gold or silver, with or without crystals
- Number Magnets

Where to Buy Items:

 Shirt & Vest - button-up fitted shirt and show vest to match. Please have approval by an instructor prior to purchase. You may find combos at:

- **Tie** Tie to match the shirt & vest combo great places to find ties are Kohls, Marshalls, Macys, Belk, Dillards, Steinmart, Burlington Coat Factory
- Jods Black, Navy or Chocolate show jods. They should be fitted and the length should go two inches beyond the heel when your rider is seated in the saddle. All jods must have tie downs and must be approved by an instructor before you alter. Can be found at the above consignment stores as well as:
