DAY	PLACE	PROGRAM
1	Dubrovnik (Croatia)	Embarkation in the port of Dubrovnik between 3 pm and 4 pm. Welcome cocktail and dinner. Overnight in port.
2	Korcula (Croatia)	Early morning sailing to Korcula. Enjoy a refreshing morning swim stop near Korcula, before arriving at Korcula port in the afternoon. According to legend, the island was founded by Trojan hero Antenor in the 12th century BC. Afternoon optional excursion to Korcula Town or both to Korcula Town and to Lumbarda Village for wine tasting. Overnight at sea to Budva Island, Montenegro.
3	Budva Island (Montenegro)	Morning arrival at the well-preserved medieval town of Budva. After breakfast, enjoy an optional sightseeing excursion to Old Budva and to Cetinje, a town-museum. Explore Budva's vast cultural heritage and Venetian architecture. Overnight at sea to Saranda, Albania.
4	Saranda (Albania) - Corfu (Greece)	Early morning arrival to the charming town of Saranda, boasting the most attractive waterfront on the Albanian Riviera. Join the optional excursion to the nearby archaeological site of Butrint or enjoy a relaxing swim. After midday, sailing to Corfu, the Grand Lady of the Ionian Islands and the greenest island in Greece. Afternoon arrival at Corfu and optional excursion. Overnight in port.
5	Corfu (Greece)- Antipaxi and Paxi (Greece)	Early morning sailing to Antipaxi Island, for a refreshing swim stop and BBQ lunch on board. Antipaxi Island, covered exclusively by olive trees and vineyards, is famous for its extraordinary beaches with the cleanest and brightest blue-green waters in the whole Ionian sea. Afternoon arrival in the unique port of Paxos. Paxos is an island that has been called one of the 20 most beautiful islands in the world, where among other things to see are the huge sea caves with turquoise waters.
6	Corfu (Greece)	Early morning sailing to Corfu. Morning optional excursion to explore Corfu's imperial past, the impressive historic centre declared UNESCO World Heritage site and the byzantine churches, or to take a scenic tour through the lush Corfiot countryside and old high hill villages. Early afternoon sailing to Kotor, Montenegro. Overnight at sea.
7	Kotor (Montenegro)	Early morning navigation in the bay of Kotor, the deepest natural fjord in the Mediterranean. Join the optional excursion to the well-preserved, fortified medieval Old Town. Late night sailing towards Dubrovnik. Overnight in port.
8	Dubrovnik (Croatia)	Disembarkation in the port of Dubrovnik after breakfast between 8 am and 9 am.
