We invite you- New Immigrant or Tourist between the ages of 22-35 with an academic degree, to take part in our Academic Hebrew intensive course.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Kibbutz Ulpan has long been considered one of the most successful programs for young adults who want to learn Hebrew and experience kibbutz life. It offers the opportunity to experience, First-hand, a lifestyle unique to Israel while meeting other young Jews from around the world.

On the One-month Kibbutz Ulpan program, you will:

Study with your peers in intensive Hebrew-language courses for 24 hours each week.

Perform volunteer work on your host kibbutz, also for 24 hours weekly. The type of work depends on the needs of the kibbutz.

Have access to a rich variety of cultural activities organized by the kibbutz and by [The Bible Comes to Life Travel and Education Center \(TBCTL\)](http://www.tbctl.com)





FAQs

How many people live in each room?

Usually 2-3 students live in each room, however arrangements vary depending on the size of the Ulpan.

Is there a store on the kibbutz?

Yes, there is a small store (markolit) that sells basic goods (food, cleaning supplies, etc.) that is open 7 days a week.

What are the eating arrangements?

Kibbutz Tzuba has an excellent dining room that serves 3 delicious, Kosher meals a day (Sunday-Friday) to the ulpanists, hotel guests, and kibbutz members. On Saturday, only breakfast and lunch are served.

How do I send and receive mail?

There is a post office located on the kibbutz. The mailing address of the kibbutz is: Your Name; Ulpan Kibbutz Tzuba; D.N. Harei; Israel 90870

How do I get to Kibbutz Tzuba?

From the Central Bus Station in Jerusalem, the #183 bus takes about 20 minutes to get to Tzuba.

How do I do my laundry?

Laundry service is provided for a small charge by the kibbutz. Clothes must be clearly labeled with your personal number that will be given to you. Expect up to a week for your laundry to be returned to you. Laundry can be picked up from the ulpan room.

Is there internet access?

Internet access is provided free of charge to the ulpanists. It is recommended to bring a laptop, however Kibbutz Tzuba is NOT responsible for lost/stolen items. A computer room with internet access is available for those who do not own a computer.

Is prior Hebrew knowledge required for the program?

No Hebrew knowledge is required. Two levels of Hebrew are taught in the Ulpan, Level A (Kita Aleph) and Level B (Kita Bet). Students will be tested and placed in the appropriate level.

Do I have to stay on the kibbutz after I am finished with work/class?

No, students are free to leave the kibbutz and travel; however they are required to return in time for work/class the next day.

Is the price includes Visa and transfers from and to the airport?

Yes, the price includes everything but the airfare to and from Israel
